2022 ALUMNI PROGRAM OF THE YEOSU ACADEMY OF THE LAW OF THE SEA

The Yeosu Academy of the Law of the Sea gladly announces launching two 2022 Alumni programs, A. The First Law of the Sea Seminar and B. The First Sharing Experience Workshop. These programs are designed to enhance alumni's capacity in the law of the sea and also to promote fellowship among the alumni, lecturers, and the Academy. Since the COVID-19 pandemic has changed the way we meet, the Academy will run the 2022 Alumni programs online. By meeting, sharing, discussing, and gathering through these fora, the Yeosu Academy hopes the alumni earn more extensive and empirical knowledge in the law of the sea.

A. The First Law of the Sea Seminar for the Yeosu Academy Alumni (virtual seminar via Zoom)

1. Invitation of presenters and discussants

- Each session consists of **three speakers** and **three to five discussants**. The lecturers of the Academy will moderate the sessions.
- **Session A:** Any Issues on Maritime Jurisdiction including Maritime Delimitation and Law Enforcement
- **Session B:** Any Issues on Marine Living and Non-living Resources
- **Session C:** Any Issues on the Protection of Marine Environment and Climate Change

2. How to apply

- Complete the **application form** and submit it **to the Secretariat of the Academy by 23 January 2022**. The Academy sent the application form via email while it is also available on the website of the Academy.
- The result of application process will be notified individually by **28 January 2022**.

3. Presentation and discussion

- **Presentation**
 - Either PPT or MS word. The length of the presentation will be **within 10 minutes**.
- **Discussion:**
 - Discussion will be **within 7 minutes**. After the seminar, discussants should submit **1-2 pages of a discussion paper** (either PPT or MS word) to the secretariat.

4. Participation benefits

- **Honorarium**
 - **500 USD** for each speaker and **250 USD** for each discussant.
- **Invitation to Korea**
 - KMI will invite three selected speakers to an international conference in Korea. KMI will provide the flight fare for round-trip, accommodation for four days and three nights, and honorarium with them.
 - If the Covid-19 situation does not improve in 2022, KMI will invite them to Korea in 2023.
- **Opportunity to publish papers**
 - The secretariat encourages the speakers to upgrade and submit their papers to the KMI International Journal of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries.
 - If the submitted paper has been **confirmed to publish** in the KMI International Journal, KMI will award **1,000 USD to the author**.
- **Gifts and souvenirs to all participants**

B. The First Sharing Experience Workshop for the Yeosu Academy Alumni (virtual workshop via Zoom)

1. Presentation and comments

- **Speakers**
 - Speakers will present maritime issues of their own country or adjacent countries.
 - In cases of settled issues, describe what were the matters and how to resolve them.
 - In cases of unsettled issues, describe what were the matters and reasons why they could not be settled, and then provide an opinion to resolve the matters.
- **Commentators**
 - Three lecturers of the Academy would provide their comments and views for each presentation and response questions in relation to the presentation.
- **Presentation**
 - Either PPT or MS word. The length of the presentation **will be within 10 minutes**.

2. Topic: any maritime issues

- Eg. maritime delimitation, law enforcement, freedom of navigation, collision at sea, dispute settlement, fisheries, marine environment, piracy and armed robbery, oil and gas development, BBNJ, sea level rise and climate change, collision, and others

3. How to apply

- Complete **the application** and submit **it to the Secretariat of the Academy by 7 February 2022**. The Academy sent the application form via email while it is also available on the website of the Academy.
- The result of application process will be notified individually by **11 February 2022**.
